Communion: Anthem - “The strife is o’er,” arranged from Melchior Vulpus by Henry Ley (NCAB pg. 458)
By loving hands the Lord is laid (no.59 from “A House of Praise,” by Timothy Dudley-Smith; T.353, Repton)
Recessional: 394 Let all the world in every corner sing
Voluntary: Chorale prelude – “Erschienen ist der herrliche tag” (BWV 629) - J S Bach

April 21st. – Fourth Sunday of Easter

Psalm: 23 The Lord is my shepherd: I shall not be in want (composed setting)
Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia at Taize chant 37– “The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice, says the Lord. I know them and they follow me.”
Offertory: 125 Alleluya! Ye sons and daughters of the King (1st.)
Communion: Anthem – “Ave Maria,” by Simon Lindley
112 Jesus lives! thy terrors now
Recessional: 436 Praise, my soul, the King of heaven
Voluntary: Overture to “Tannhäuser” – Richard Wagner

April 28th. – Fifth Sunday of Easter

Psalm: 22 All the ends of the earth shall turn to you O Lord (composer setting)
Gospel Acclamation: plainsong Alleluia – “I am the first and the last, says the Lord, and the living one; I was dead, and behold I am alive for evermore.”
Offertory: from A&M 2013, no.208 Light’s glittering morn bedecks the sky (T.263, Lasst uns Erfreuen)
Agnus Dei: from setting in F by Harold Darke
Communion: plainsong proper (687)
Anthem – “Cantique de Jean Racine,” by Gabriel Fauré
115 Now the green blade riseth from the buried grain
Recessional: 124 Ye choirs of new Jerusalem
Voluntary: Prelude and Fugue in G major – J S Bach

May 5th. – Patronal Festival

Psalm (if reqd.): 117 The Lord spoke to him face to face (both parags; v. gps.11)
Gradual: from A&M 2013, no.308 - Rejoice in God’s saints today and all days (T.433, Hanover)

Communion: Anthem – “Blesséd are the pure in heart,” by Henry Walford Davies (CAB no.6)

Thursday, May 9th - Ascension Day

Sunday, May 12th – Seventh Sunday of Easter

Psalm: 1 (use words from "Psalms for the Common Era"; T.346, Richmond; remain seated)
Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia from Benjamin Britten's "A Ceremony of Carols" – "Come Holy Spirit fill the hearts of your faithful people, and kindle in them the fire of your love"
Offertory: 332 All hail the power of Jesu's name (v.7 descant)
Communion: Anthem - "From all that dwell below the skies," by TA Walmisley
Come Celebrate 106 – He walked by the river where the crowds had gone (T.375, Lord of the Dance)
Recessional: 443 Rejoice, The Lord is King
Voluntary: Chorale Prelude – "Heut' triumphiret Gottes Sohn" (BWV 630) – J S Bach

Sunday, May 19th – Pentecost

Processional: 137 Come down, O Love divine
Psalm: hymn 537 (=Ps.104) Send forth your Spirit O Lord, and renew the face of the earth
Gospel Acclamation: Celtic Alleluia – "Come Holy Spirit fill the hearts of your faithful people, and kindle in them the fire of your love"
Offertory: 142 Sing to him in whom creation (T. 351, Neander)
Agnus Dei: from setting in C by John Ireland
Communion: plainsong proper (691)
Anthem – "Litany to the Holy Spirit," by Peter Hurford (sopranos and altos)
431 O thou who camest from above
Recessional: 355 Eternal ruler of the ceaseless round
Voluntary: Festival Fanfare by Noel Rawsthorne

Sunday, May 26th – Trinity Sunday

Processional: 146 Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty
Psalm: 29 The Lord shall give his people the blessing of peace (composed setting)
Gradual: 377 Immortal, invisible, God only wise
Offertory: 148 omit v.5 The God of Abraham praise
Communion: Anthem – "Holy, holy, holy," by Franz Schubert (CAB no.31)
408 Love Divine, all loves excelling (1st.)
Recessional: 343 Bright the vision that delighted (vv.3,6 descant)
Voluntary: "St. Anne" Fugue in E flat (BWV 552) – J S Bach

Sunday, June 2nd – Corpus Christi Sunday

Processional: 433 O worship the King all glorious above
Psalm (if reqd.): 116 I will walk in the presence of the Lord in the land of the living (composed setting; two verses)
Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia at Taize chant 13 "I give you a new commandment says the Lord: Love one another as I have loved you."
Offertory: 296 Lord, enthroned in heavenly splendour (1st.)
Communion: Anthem: "Ave verum corpus," by W A Mozart (NCAB pg.48)
277 Bread of the world in mercy broken
Recessional: 271 Alleluya, sing to Jesus (v.4 descant)
Setting: Congress Mass, by Alan Rees (until July 28th, but Agnus Dei different on June 9th & 23rd.)
Voluntary: to come

Sunday, June 9th. – Second Sunday after Trinity

Processional: 473 When morning gilds the skies (2nd.)

Psalm: 130 With the Lord there is mercy and plenteous redemption (v. gps.2222)

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia at Taize chant 37 – “The word of the Lord endures for ever. The word of the Lord is the good news announced to you”

Offertory: 439 Praise to the holiest in the height (1st.)

Agnus Dei: from setting in A flat by Basil Harwood

Communion: Anthem – “All things bright and beautiful,” by John Rutter
294 Just as I am, without one plea

Recessional: 321 Go forth for God: go forth to the world in peace (T.186, Woodlands)

Voluntary: Fugue in G Major (BWV 576) – J S Bach

Sunday, June 30th. – Fifth Sunday after Trinity

Psalm: 30 To you O Lord my heart shall sing without ceasing (parags.1,2,5; v.gps.222)

Gospel Acclamation: plainsong Alleluia – “I am the light of the world, says the Lord. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.”

Offertory: 383 Jesu, Lover of my soul (1st.)

Communion: Anthem – “Lead me, Lord,” by S S Wesley

276 Bread of heaven, on thee we feed (1st.)

Recessional: 339 Be thou my vision
