## **The Gathering**

### **THE GREETING**

### **THE RECEPTION OF HOLY OILS**

#### ***The oil of the sick:***

By the laying on of hands and anointing with this oil,  
and with the prayerful support of this community,  
may those who are sick experience the healing presence of Christ. **Amen.**

#### ***The oil of Baptism:***

Anointed with this oil,  
and assisted by the example of this community,  
may those who are to be baptized know that Christ calls them by name  
and makes them his own and shares with them  
his victory over sin and the power of evil. **Amen.**

#### ***The oil of Chrism:***

Anointed with this fragrant oil,  
may all who are baptized and confirmed,  
all who are ordained to the service of God's people,  
and this community whose house of prayer is dedicated to God's glory,  
fill the world with the sweet fragrance of Christ's gospel  
and be built up as living stones into a temple  
filled with the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

## **PRAYERS OF PENITENCE**

## **THE GOSPEL READING:** *John 13: 1-17, 31b-35*

*When the Gospel is announced the reader says*

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, according to John.  
**Glory to you, O Lord.**

*At the end*

This is the Gospel of the Lord.  
**Praise to you, O Christ.**

*All sit*

## **SERMON**

Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us that what we do  
for the least of our brothers and sisters we do also for you:  
give us the will to be the servant of others  
as you were the servant of all,  
and gave up your life and died for us,  
but are alive and reign, now and for ever. **Amen.**

*All sit or kneel*

## **PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION**

In the power of the Spirit let us pray to the Father  
through Christ the Saviour of the world.

Father, on this, the night he was betrayed,  
your Son Jesus Christ washed his disciples' feet.  
We commit ourselves to follow his example of love and service.

Lord, hear us  
**and humble us.**

On this night, he prayed for his disciples to be one.  
We pray for the unity of your Church.

Lord, hear us  
**and unite us.**

On this night, he prayed for those  
who were to believe through his disciples' message.  
We pray for the mission of your Church.

Lord, hear us  
**and renew our zeal.**

On this night, he commanded his disciples to love,  
but suffered rejection himself.  
We pray for the rejected and unloved.

Lord, hear us  
**and fill us with your love.**

On this night, he reminded his disciples  
that if the world hated them it hated him first.  
We pray for those who are persecuted for their faith.

Lord, hear us  
**and give us your peace.**

On this night, he accepted the cup of death  
and looked forward to the new wine of the kingdom.  
We remember those who have died in the peace of Christ.

Lord, hear us  
**and welcome all your children into paradise.**

## **PRAYER OF HUMBLE ACCESS**

**Most merciful Lord,  
your love compels us to come in.  
Our hands were unclean,  
our hearts were unprepared;  
we were not fit even to eat the crumbs from under your table.  
But you, Lord, are the God of our salvation,  
and share your bread with sinners.  
So cleanse and feed us with the precious body  
and blood of your Son,  
that he may live in us and we in him;  
and that we, with the whole company of Christ,  
may sit and eat in your kingdom. Amen.**

## **THE PEACE**

Jesus says: 'Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.  
Do not let your hearts be troubled,  
neither let them be afraid.'

The peace of the Lord be always with you  
**and also with you.**

Let us offer one another a sign of God's peace.

## **PREPARATION OF THE TABLE**

*The table is prepared and bread and wine are placed upon it*

## **OFFERTORY PRAYER**

At the eucharist we are with our crucified and risen Lord.  
We know that it was not only our ancestors,  
but we who were redeemed  
and brought forth from bondage to freedom,  
from mourning to feasting.

We know that as he was with them in the upper room  
so our Lord is here with us now.

**Until the kingdom of God comes  
let us celebrate this feast.**

## **THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER**

The Lord be with you  
**and also with you.**

Lift up your hearts.  
**We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.  
**It is right to give thanks and praise.**

*The president gives thanks for God's work in creation*

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.  
Hosanna in the highest.

*The president recalls the Last Supper*

Christ is the bread of life:  
**When we eat this bread and drink this cup,  
we proclaim your death, Lord Jesus, until you come in glory.**

*At the end of the prayer we say together **Amen.***

## **THE LORD'S PRAYER**

Lord Jesus, remember us in your kingdom and teach us to pray.

**Our Father, who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy name;  
thy kingdom come; thy will be done;  
on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.

## **GIVING OF COMMUNION**

*The president says*

Jesus is the Lamb of God,  
who takes away the sin of the world;  
Blessed are those who are called to his supper.  
**Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,  
but only say the word, and I shall be healed.**

## **PRAYER OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION**

**Lord, you stand at the door and knock.  
You wait for me and only I can let you in.  
I believe and trust in you and ask you  
now to fill me with your presence.  
Feed me with your body and unite me in your blood,  
that I may be your blessing to a world in need.  
Amen.**

*The congregation remain in their seats as communion is distributed*

The body and blood of Christ keep you in eternal life.

## **POST COMMUNION PRAYER**

Eternal God and Father,  
whose Son at supper prayed that his disciples might be one,  
as he is one with you:  
draw us closer to him,  
that in common love and obedience to you  
we may be united to one another  
in the fellowship of the one Spirit,  
that the world may believe that he is Lord,  
to your eternal glory;  
through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

## **PSALM 22**

### **THE ALTAR OF REPOSE AND STRIPPING OF THE ALTARS**

*After Holy Communion the Blessed Sacrament is placed on the Altar of Repose, where it will be in place for the faithful to keep vigil. Following the service, the altars are stripped, as a sign of the utter dereliction of Christ himself. This symbolizes that the Lord has left the upper room where the Last Supper and Footwashing took place, and the Apostles have gone with Jesus into the Garden of Gethsemane to keep watch.*
