Psalm: 23 The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want (composed setting)

Solo: Pie Jesu (from the Requiem) – Gabriel Fauré
Voluntary “How fair and pleasant art thou” (Antiphon, Op.18, No.5) – Marcel Dupré

November 7th. – Third Sunday before Advent

Processional: 433 O worship the King all glorious above (v.6 descant)
Psalm: 62 God alone is my rock and my salvation (verse groups 2222)
Communion: Anthem – “The First Disciples,” by John Webber
A&M 2013 no.598 Before the throne of God above
Setting: Nashdom Mass, by Anthony Greening (Gloria, Sanctus, Benedictus and Agnus Dei)
Voluntary: Partita sopra la Aria della Folia da Spagna – Bernardo Pasquini

November 14th. – Second Sunday before Advent (Remembrance Sunday), with brass

Processional: 120 Thine be the glory, risen, conquering Son
Gloria & Psalm omitted
Communion: Anthem – “Richard de Castre’s Prayer to Jesus,” by Richard Terry
Walking outside: “Nimrod” (from “Enigma” Variations) – Edward Elgar (brass)
At the Calvary: Last Post and Reveille (trumpet)
417 O God, our help in ages past (with brass)
At the end: Largo (“New World” Symphony) – Antonin Dvorák (brass)

November 21st. – Christ the King

Processional: 352 Crown him with many crowns
Psalm: 93 The Lord has girded himself with strength (v.gps.321)
Communion: Anthem – “Jesus, the very thought,” by Edward Bairstow (NCAB 197)
Voluntary: Trumpet Tune in C major – Noel Rawsthorne

November 28th. – First Sunday of Advent (Year C begins)

Introit: Advent prose v.1 (hymn 501)
Processional: 9 Lo! he comes with clouds descending
Psalm: 25 To you O Lord I lift up my soul (paragraphs 1,3; v. gps.22)
Communion: Anthem – “People, look East” – Besanson carol melody, arr. Malcolm Archer (NOEAB 176)
Angelus: sung (descant v.3)
Setting: Dean and Fry (Kyrie, Sanctus, Benedictus, Acclamations, Agnus Dei)
